Annotated Works Cited (AKA Annotated Bibliography)

Requirements:

- 1. **must** have minimum 6 total sources:
 - a. 3 online subscriptions/databases
 - b. 2 other sources
 - c. field research (tentative)
- 2. **must** have a small paragraph for each source that discusses credibility of sources, relevance and appropriateness for this paper. Consider:
 - a. how well it addresses your essential questions what does it give information about?
 - b. how well it makes sense
 - c. how well it compares or contrasts with other sources and where it cites its information
- 3. each entry must start with a correctly formatted MLA 8 citation

Example:

"Lives of Poets: Seamus Heaney." *Literature: Reading Fiction, Poetry, and Drama*. Ed. Robert DiYanni. 5th ed. New York: McGraw-Hill, 2002. 1145.

This short entry gives me a brief overview of Heaney's life with some key details. As a literature textbook, its inclusion of author biography would have been verified through research, so it's a credible source. It gives me a framework for formulating further questions about how his life affects his writing, particularly his Irish influences and how his work addresses "themes of nature and history as well as politics." It also connects Heaney as the successor to Yeats, so I might do some research on Yeats' poetry if I fall short on information for Heaney.

**It is recommended to NOT fill out an annotation entry until you are sure you may actually USE this source. It is a waste of time and energy to use it for this assignment and then have to find all new research later because you were lazy ©
